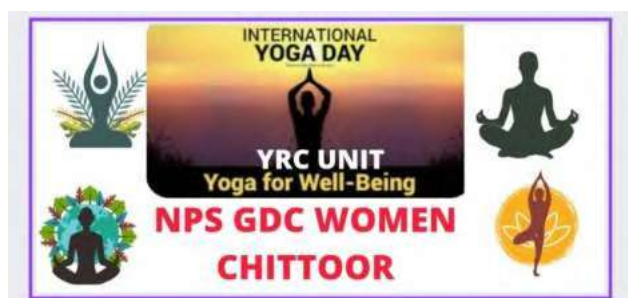


STUDENTS AWARENESS ON COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECT

Hindi divas program

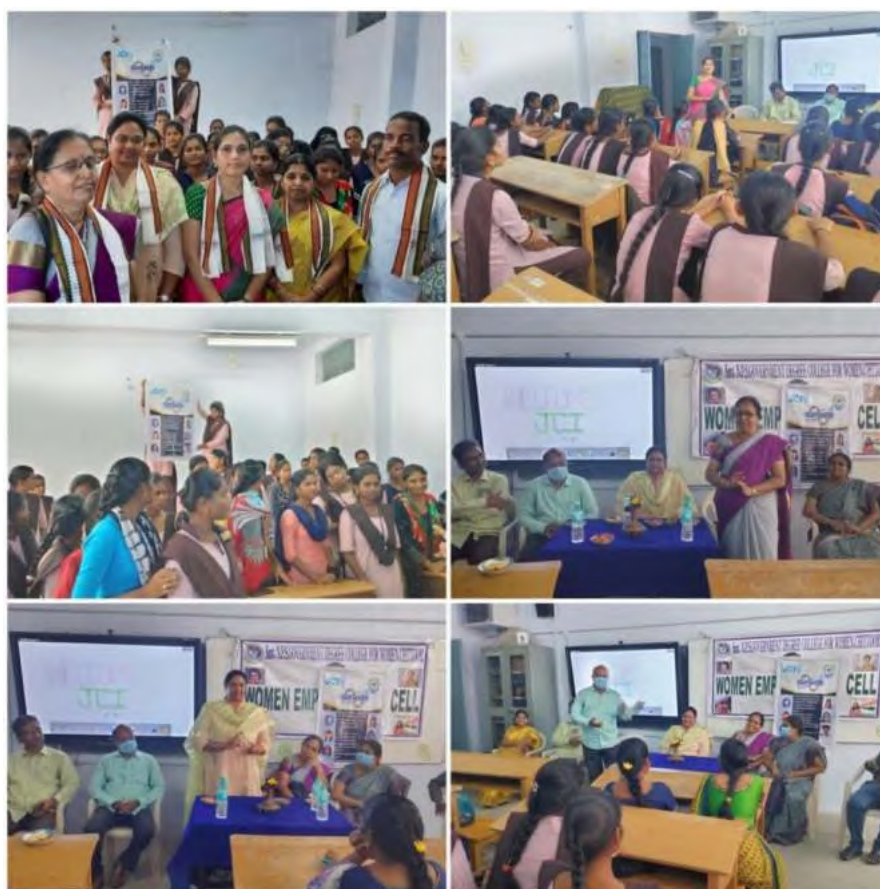
