Smt. N.P. Savitramma Government College for Women, Chittoor, was established in 1982 on 23 acres of land generously donated by Smt. N.P. Savitramma to promote women's education. Since its inception, the college has grown remarkably, offering excellent academics integrated with moral values, innovative curricula, and practical knowledge essential for life and career.

Dr. K. Manohar has been serving as the Principal since 2021, providing exemplary leadership.

Notable Achievements

- In April 2023, the college was reaccredited with an '**A**' Grade by NAAC.
- An Autonomous Proposal was submitted soon after NAAC reaccreditation, and we anticipate obtaining autonomous status in the next academic year.

Infrastructure Details

The college boasts adequate infrastructure to support all-round student development:

- **Classrooms:** A total of 22 classrooms, including ICT-enabled digital, virtual, and projector-equipped facilities.
- **Laboratories:** Well-equipped labs catering to the needs of various science streams.
- **Gym:** A fully functional gymnasium to promote physical fitness.
- **Library:** A well-stocked library with a wide range of books, journals, and digital resources.
- **Playground:** A spacious playground to encourage outdoor sports and games

Hostels and Infrastructure

- The college has two hostels for SC/ST students, and two BC hostels.
- This academic year, ₹7.2 lakh was spent on renovating the SC Hostel, and ₹16 lakh was sanctioned for further renovation.

Our college is the second-largest women's college in Chittoor district.

Academic Developments

- The Andhra Pradesh State Government implemented the NEP 2020 and introduced a single major system.
- **Eight undergraduate programmes** (BA History, BA Economics, B.Com General, B.Com CA, BBA, B.Sc Computer Science, B.Sc Chemistry, B.Sc Zoology) and four minor groups (Microbiology, Mathematics, Political Science) were launched, along with **two PG courses** (M.Sc Microbiology and M.Com).
- Intensive admission drives were conducted, leading to the **admission of 248 students for the academic year 2023-2024**. Currently, **584 students are enrolled across all years**.

Faculty and Results

- **Faculty: 29** (16 permanent, 5 contract, 8 guest lecturers).
- **Results:**
 - First-year: 69% pass rate (158/228).
 - Second-year: 62% pass rate (98/158).
 - Third-year: 77.4% pass rate (137/177).
