Title of the Practice: ADOPTION OF VILLAGE

Objectives of the Practice:

To create awareness about the ill effects of drinking alcohol in various aspects of health, family and to the society

To enlighten the people of the village about the government schemes available for a better living
To create awareness about the importance of 'cleanliness' to the society

The Context: The NSS Program Officers and NSS volunteers met the local leaders, Panchayat Secretaries, ward members, village school masters and other NGOs in the KothapallimittaHarizanawada, discussed the burning problems and appraised them of the mission for the all-round development of village.

The Practice: The NSS unit of the college comprising, The NSS programme officer and volunteers organised a camp in the village mainly targeting on four major aspects: health and hygiene, awareness on the ill effectors of drinking, enlightening about government schemes. Women Education. In this connection, the NSS team organised an awareness camp to the people about the hazardous effects that drinking might cause to a person, family and eventually to the society. Further, the students enlightened the people about the various government schemes that they could avail to improve their quality of life. 'Cleanliness, a major aspect for the better health, living of the society as also emphasised in the camp. In this regard, the students put their hands together and conducted campus cleaning in a government school. Finally, the main aspect of the camp of getting the girls educated thereby paving way for women empowerment was dealt by arranging different awareness sessions.

Problems Encountered and Resources required: The students we found it difficult to deal with certain drunken people as they were not willing to participate in the session
Most of women in the village were daily labours and were not available to participate in sessions of women empowerment
