The best way of reusing articles happened through this activity

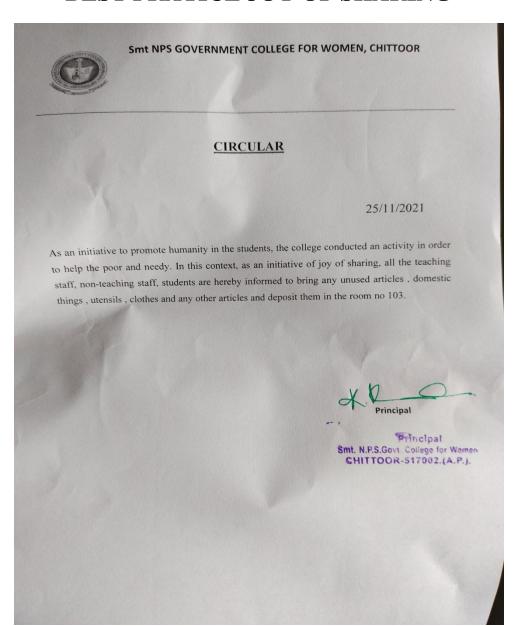
The best utilisation of articles took place as most of the people took an opportunity to acquire articles

During the initial days of collection of articles, there are hardly any people to come and get the things

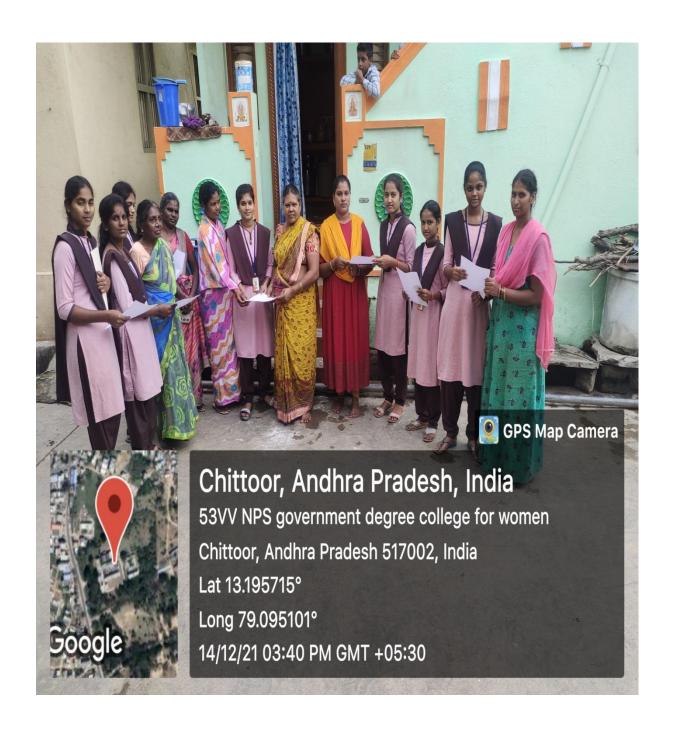
