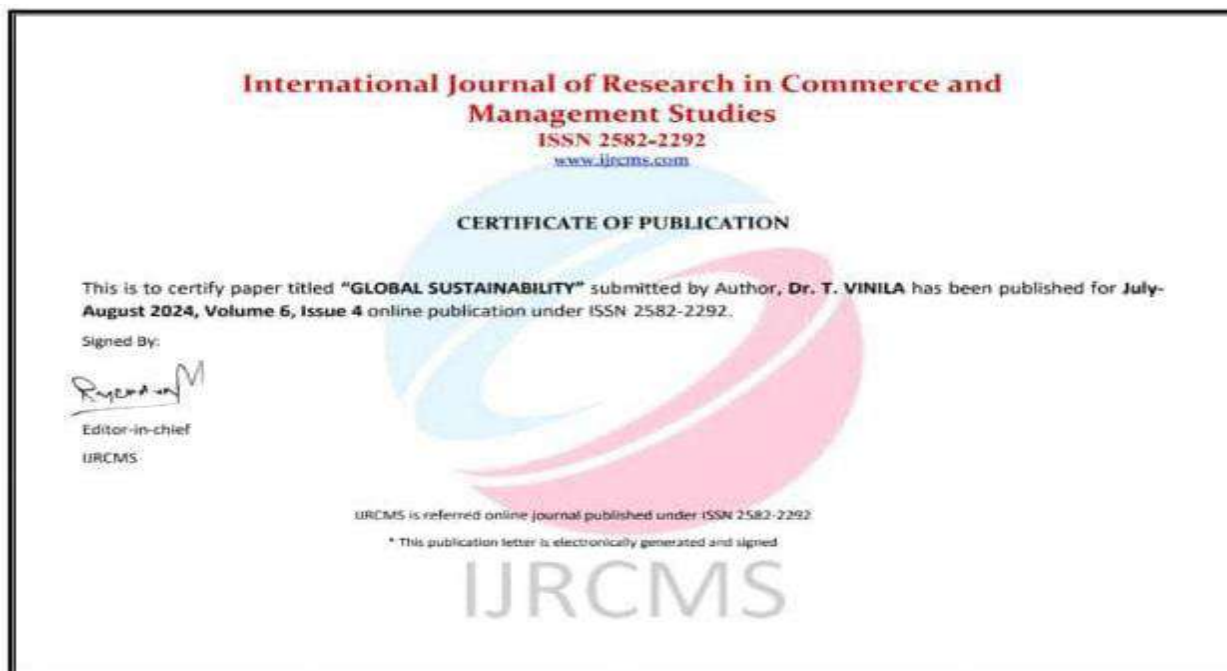
FDP

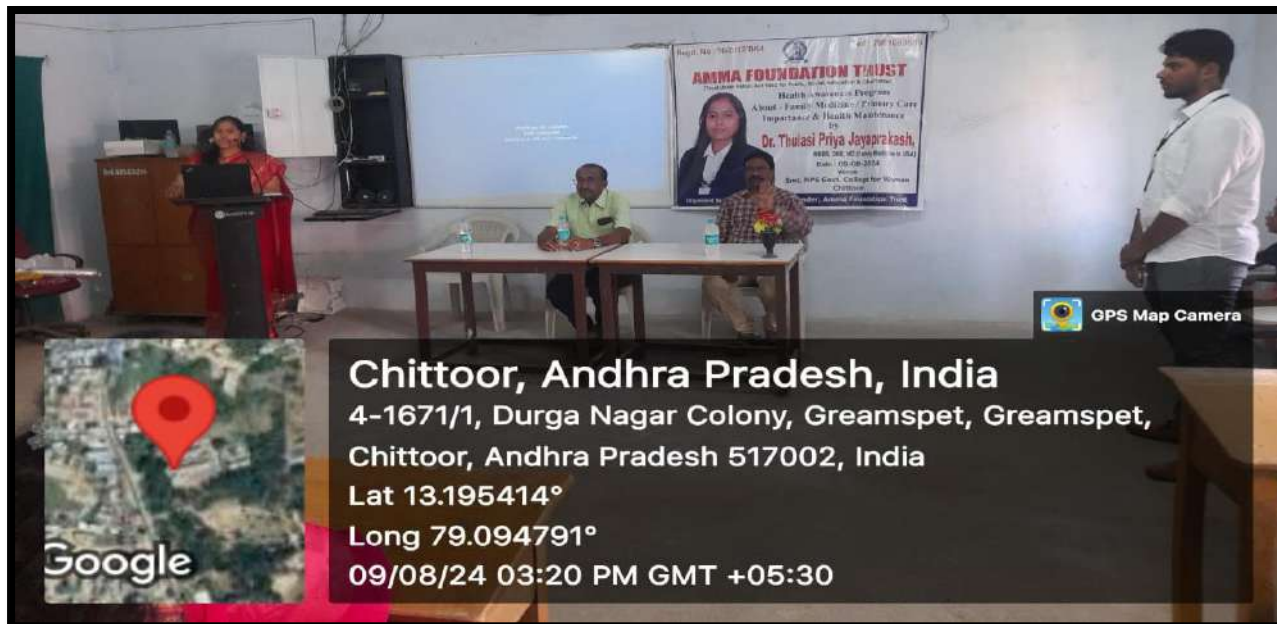
