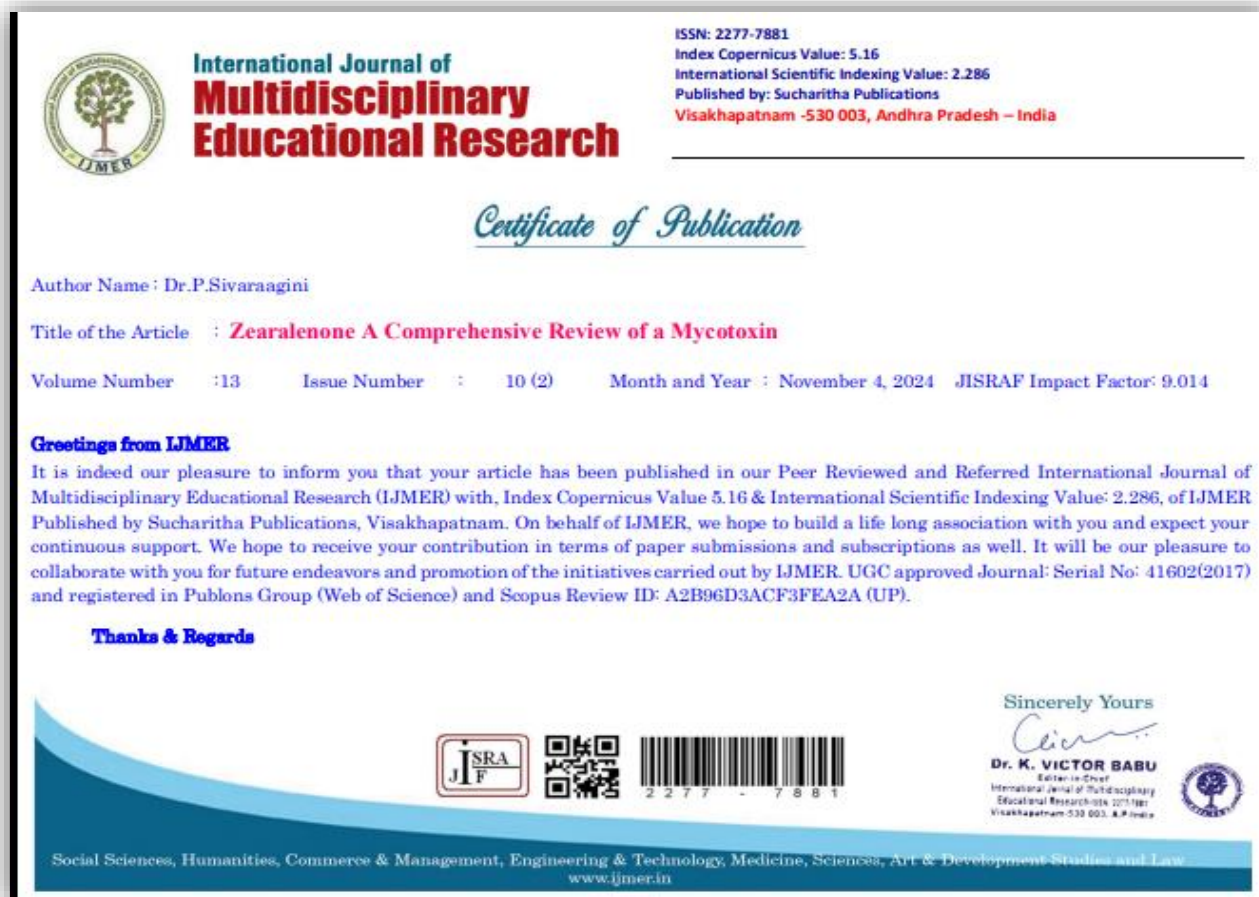

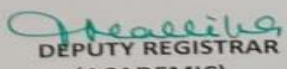

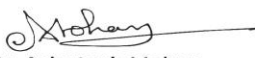

The pace of advancements in the area of technology is rapid, dynamic and striving to impact every part of modern society and the Artificial Intelligence (AI) as a high value emerging technology currently attracts global attention. AI is a set of technologies that enable computers to perform a variety of advanced functions, including the ability to see, understand and translate spoken and written language, analyze data, make recommendations and more.

AI is a broad field that encompasses many different disciplines including computer science, data analytics and statistics, hardware and software engineering, linguistics, neuroscience and even philosophy and psychology.

India, being the most populous country, the fifth largest economy in terms of GDP and the second largest internet user base in the world with a rapidly growing tech talent pool, is witnessing a surge in AI research and development. The National Strategy for Artificial Intelligence launched in 2019 aims to make India a global leader in AI by 2030. The Indian govt.'s proactive stance and the active role of private sector in promoting AI have resulted in increased funding for research, the establishment of AI centres of excellence and the promotion of AI start-ups in India. Thus AI is revolutionizing India's digital economy, improving services across sectors like banking, health and agriculture and offering personalized consumer experiences. It is estimated that the General Artificial Intelligence could boost India's GDP by \$359 - 438b by 2030 representing a 5.9-7.2 per cent increase.

Against this background, a ICSSR funded National Seminar on 'Artificial Intelligence' is being organized by the Department of Commerce. The main theme of the Seminar is to provide rich insights and better understanding of the concept of AI and its current trends to the participants representing from academia and industry.

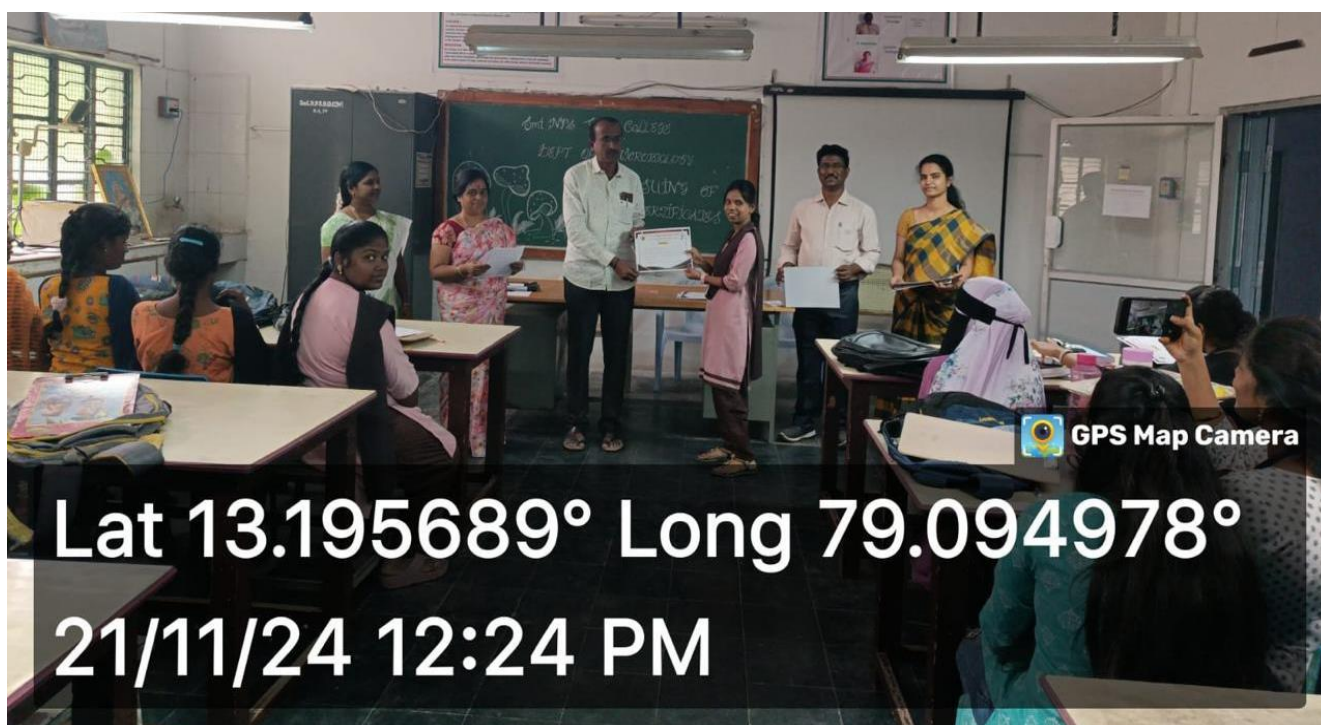
Certification Course:

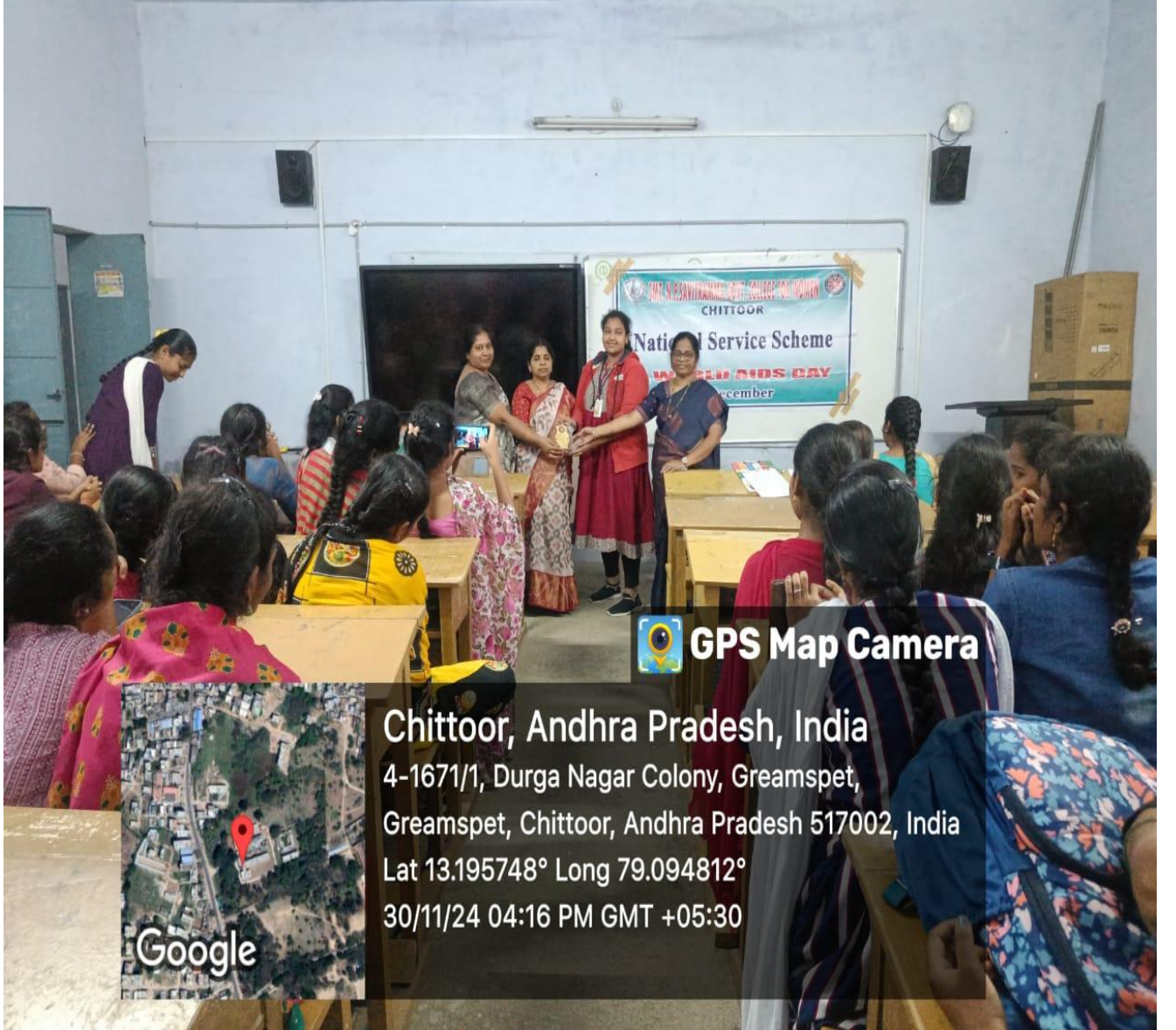


Constitution Day:
