




A Community Service Project (CSP) is a program or initiative that encourages students to engage in volunteer work or activities that benefit their local community for 45 days

Personal Growth students often develop a sense of empathy, social responsibility, and a deeper understanding of social issues.


Skill Development Participation in CSPs can enhance a wide range of skills, including communication, teamwork, leadership, and project management.


