1. STAFF ACHIEVEMENTS

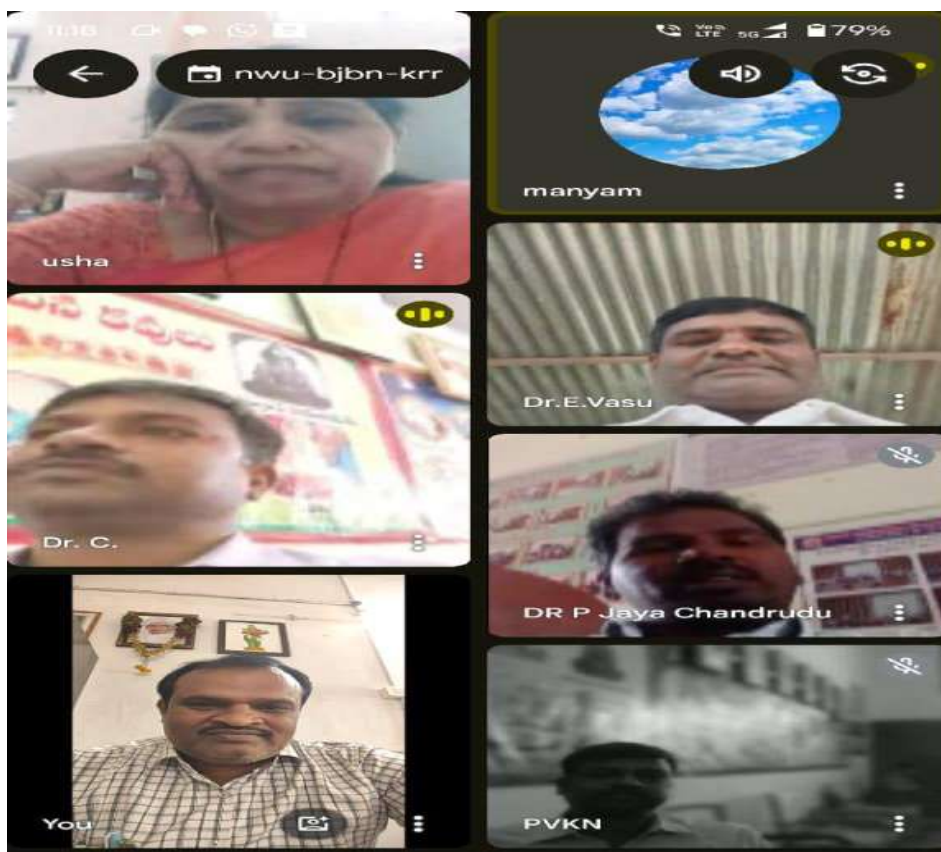
(Awards and achievements)
